**4. MANAGERS REPORT**

Renee mentioned that the Riverwalk Rec Center is having Dr. Seuss days today, March 3, Wednesday, March 4, and that the schools will be here on Thursday, March 5. This Saturday, March 7, Riverblitz will be happening here at the Riverwalk Recreation Center from 7 a.m. to 11 a.m. The participants return to have lunch and hope to win one of the door prizes. The bottom gym floor has been completed. There is a concern about a trip hazard, so they will be laying a transition from the gym court floor to the regular floor. Phase one of the building repainting has been completed; they are looking to allocate funds to move on to Phase two. The hockey rink got some light poles put in. Renee replied that she will check on that. Renee mentioned that she has received a quote to paint the blank floor in front of the racquetball courts and the mezzanine. In one of the grants we received, there is some leftover money to purchase new furniture for the front entry area. We have received a quote of \$45,000 to replace all doors on the bottom floor to improve the HVAC system's efficiency. We are looking to have some pads put up on the third-floor wall that was built. We have been busy on the basketball courts, with the Boys and Girls Club teams practicing here, and we have a large group of gentlemen coming to play volleyball weekly. We have been looking into getting drop-down curtains to help divide the courts. Our staff has been taking a lot of safety training. We are already starting to get things ready for the Fourth of July. Renee mentioned that we have 1 full-time and 2 part-time positions open, and that our 4 seasonal positions will be put out to the public within the next month. Becky Fierro asked how many hours the seasonal employees work. Renee replied to up to 40 hours a week for the seasonal time frame from Memorial Day to Labor Day.

Richard Carrasco inquired if we would be doing an Easter Egg hunt. Renee stated yes.
